



Dates

P7 Code Club will start up again for the new school year on **Wednesday 14 September 2016**. With a couple of exceptions (see paragraph below), the club will meet every Wednesday this term finishing up on **Wednesday 14 December 2016**. We will also continue through the spring term – dates still to be confirmed.

Exceptions: the club will not meet on 12 October (parent evening) and 19 October (half term break).

Times

The club commences promptly at **6:30pm** and finishes at **8:00pm**.

The school entrance will be manned from 6:20pm to 6:30pm. Outside of these times there can be no assurance that there will be anyone available at the front door to let your child into the school building so please ensure that your child arrives on time (see security procedures below).

Security Procedures (IMPORTANT)

The club will be located in room 27 of the main school building (the science room).

There are security procedures covering access to the school after 3.15pm. No parent/carer will be allowed inside the school building at this time. A member of the code club volunteer team will be located at the glass door of the school and will hold a register of members for the club. Your child **must** register with this person on arrival and also sign out. Parents/carers are not allowed to wait in the corridor outside the School Office during class time – and are not permitted to sit in the Library or Music Room during the classes. This may sound very strict but all clubs must adhere to these arrangements. Any club that doesn't follow these rules will not be allowed to run.

Subscription Fees

Thanks to the generosity of the parent council in funding all of our start-up costs last year, we will not be charging a subscription fee this year.

Kit Requirements

All children will need to have access to their own Raspberry Pi kit and bring it with them to the club every week. The club will provide monitors, keyboards and mice in the classroom.

Kids who already have a Raspberry Pi

We know that some kids already have Raspberry Pis at home. We are happy to accommodate existing V1B+, V2 & V3 Raspberry Pis within the club. However, anything older than this (i.e. V1B) will struggle to run the desktop environment that we will be using. Kids who already have a Raspberry Pi will need to bring a micro SD card and a USB memory stick with them that will be wiped and set up as needed for the club. If you don't have any spares that can be wiped, we can supply you with a set for a small charge. If you wish to take us up on this offer, please confirm this in the form below.
